What household chore do you hate to do? Is it ironing? cleaning the bathroom? doing laundry? washing dishes? dusting?

shoveling snow off the sidewalk? It seems like everyone has at least one household chore they really don't like to do. But our answers will vary, depending on our preferences.

But there's <u>one</u> thing <u>almost no one</u> likes to do. And that's self-reflection. It's asking yourself, "What are my faults and shortcomings?". And as Christians, it's asking yourself, "What are all the ways that I've chosen to rebel against God <u>today</u> (by not following God's commandments)?". And not just in what we've done. But as we confess in worship... "we have sinned against you (God) in <u>thought</u>, word, and <u>deed</u>".

How have we sinned against God in the <u>thoughts</u> that have gone through our head? Or in the <u>words</u> that have come from our mouth (or written in a text, email, letter, or something we've posted on the internet)? Or in the <u>deeds or actions</u> we've done... at home, at work, at school, at the grocery store, while driving, etc.?

Almost no one likes doing self-reflection. But as Christians, it's vital to our relationship with God, and with one another. As we hear in 1st John, "If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, (God) is faithful and just, and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say we have not sinned, we make (God) a liar, and His word is not in us." (1 John 1:8-10)

Lent is a time of deep self-reflection. It reminds us of the parable Jesus told about the man who humbled himself before God, "But the tax collector, standing far off, would not even lift up his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me, a sinner!"". (Luke 18:13)

Lent is a time of reminding ourselves of how deeply sinful we really are, and humbly coming before God to confess those sins. It's only then that we can feel the full impact of what God's forgiveness really means, and everything Jesus did to give up His own life to save us.

We invite you to join us for the season of Lent, and entering into a time of deep self-reflection, and the revelation of how gracious, loving, and forgiving God really is. And how we can offer that same kind of love to our neighbors, even (and especially) to those whom we consider our enemies. Thanks be to God!
